A brief summary of the training program:

WEDNESDAY, JULY 16 - Plenary session presenters from Safe Haven and Oskey-Wapitah will discuss their successful collaboration. Breakout sessions will include topics that intersect with domestic violence and sexual assault such as: human trafficking, traumatic brain injury, and the White Bison Healing Movement in WI, as well as a deeper exploration of collaborative work.

THURSDAY, JULY 17 - Thursday's plenary session will feature an in-depth look at the Adverse Childhood Experiences Study (ACES). Breakout topics include local prevention work, and the intersection of domestic violence, sexual assault and substance abuse. We will also enjoy a performance by Menominee Youth.
